Register your table early to take advantage of Early Bird pricing, and individual registrations are also welcome. Please advise any special diet requirements by email at least one week prior.

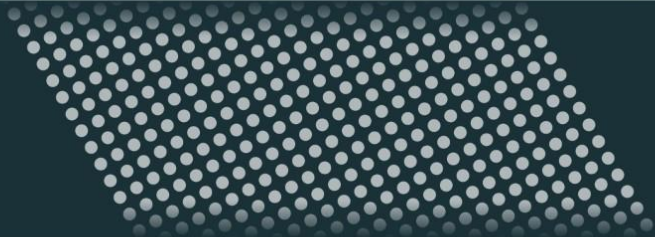
